Tournament Rules

1. The following rules of the tournament will be used. These rules will be interpreted solely by the Tournament Director and all decisions final.
2. Eligibility - All individuals. Those under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult or legal guardian. Contestants need not be a member of BASS, MOBass Federation Nation or Smithville Bassmasters
3. Entry Fee: \$100.00 per boat includes \$10 into Big Bass Pool. Send entries to Smithville Bassmasters - PO Box 257 Smithville, MO 64089 - CASH ONLY entries will also be accepted at the HWY W Ramp at Smithville Lake between 5:15am to 6am September 10th, 2016. Take off order determined by order of entries received.
4. Headquarters & Times: Smithville Lake HWY W ramp - fishing times are 6 am to 3:00pm September 10th, 2016.
5. Livewells will be checked before take off.
6. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is not allowed during official tournament hours and until the completion of the weigh-in.
7. Tackle & Equipment: Only artificial lures or pork style baits are allowed (no LIVE bait), all bass must be caught on a rod & reel during tournament hours. Use of one rod & reel combination at a time.
8. Boats & Equipment: Any boat 14' feet or longer powered by an engine of 20hp or more. No stick steering or tiller steering. Boat must be equipped with a functional aerator livewell. Boats may not be trailered during tournament hours. All Missouri Water Patrol laws and regulations shall apply.
9. Safety & Sportsmanship: Safe boating and fishing practices must be observed. Life jackets must be worn during departure and when the outboard is running, ignition kill switches must be operational. Running lights must be on during departure.
10. Permitted fishing locations: Will be determined by the Tournament Director.
11. Scoring: Largemouth, Kentucky, Smallmouth Bass will be counted. Total stringer weight will determine placing. 15" minimum length to be weighed in and short fish will result in a 2 LB deduction of total weight and loss of short fish any dead fish will result in a 1 LB deduction and frozen, iced or mangled fish results in immediate disqualification.
12. Ties: Ties will be broken by earliest starting position.
13. Late Check-in penalty: All boats MUST be checked-in and inside the no wake buoys at the ramp by 3pm or be subject to disqualification.
14. Tournament Cancellation: If tournament is canceled due to safety on Saturday Sept. 10th, 2016 Entry fees will be refunded. No refunds will be made for any other reason.
